

### **ELIGIBILITY**



	<ol> <li>Innovation (25%)</li> <li>Creativity in responding to and addressing community needs through STEM</li> <li>Use of innovative methods, technologies, or approaches.</li> </ol>
	3. Scalability (15%)  Potential for the proposed project to be replicated or adapted in other communities.  Feasibility of implementation in different settings or regions.
	Community Engagement (15%)     Level of involvement and collaboration with community members.     Contribution to raising awareness and education on STEM-related issues.
