

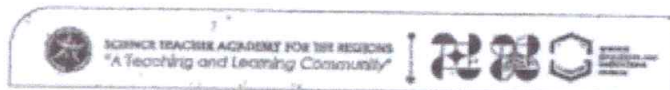

<p>Initial Screening and Evaluation October 26 – November 14, 2024</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All submitted proposals shall be screened and evaluated by the Search Committee • The following criteria will be used for the selection: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Impact (30%) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Measurable outcomes of the proposed project in terms of community benefits. ◦ Long-term sustainability and positive change to be brought about by the proposed project. 2. Innovation (25%) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Creativity in responding to and addressing community needs through STEM ◦ Use of innovative methods, technologies, or approaches. 3. Scalability (15%) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Potential for the proposed project to be replicated or adapted in other communities. ◦ Feasibility of implementation in different settings or regions. 4. Community Engagement (15%) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Level of involvement and collaboration with community members. ◦ Contribution to raising awareness and education on STEM-related issues. 5. Presentation and Documentation (15%) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Clarity, coherence, and professionalism of the proposal ◦ Quality of supporting materials (e.g., photos, videos, endorsements).
<p>Announcement of Semi-finalists November 15, 2024</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After the screening and evaluation, semi-finalists shall be announced.
<p>STARS CAMP (Capacitating and Mentoring Program) November 25-27, 2024</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All the semi-finalists are required to attend the STARS CAMP. • The proposal must be presented by each team. • Proposals are subject to the revisions as recommended by the Search committee and mentors. • After the CAMP, three (3) proposals will be chosen as finalists for implementation.
<p>Implementation and Monitoring Activities February to October 2025</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Search committee shall conduct monitoring and evaluation activities. • Implementation activities should be accomplished within the deadline.
