In reference to the Boy Scout of the Philippines (BSP) Council Office Memorandum No. 19, s. 2024 dated September 24, 2024, the field is informed that the Boy Scout of the Philippines – Davao del Sur Council will conduct the  $67^{th}$  Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and  $28^{th}$  Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI) on October 18-20, 2024 at Padada National High School, Northern Paligue, Padada, Davao del Sur.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES. The activity aims to encourage scouts to reach out to other scouts all over the province, the country, and the world through amateur radio and internet connection. This will also include interaction and communication with other cultures and diversities all over the world.

QUALIFICATIONS. Participating Boy Scouts, Senior Scouts and Adult Leaders must be currently registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, physically fit to undergo strenuous activities with corresponding parental consent and must be equipped with camping gear.

PARTICIPATION QUOTA. To exercise an effective and efficient learning environment, a ratio of One (1) Unit Leader and Eight (8) Scouts (8) is allowed to participate and shall report on October 18, 2024, at 5:00 PM at the venue.

REGISTRATION: A Registration Fee of THREE HUNDRED PESOS (P 300.00) shall be collected from each participant to defray costs of materials needed and other administrative expenses.

Corresponding service credits and/ or compensatory overtime credits (COC) shall be granted to all accompanying Adult Leaders and Staff who will participate and serve, respectively during the activity as provided for in DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003.

- The Boy Scouts of the Philippines Davao del Sur Council will participate in the 67<sup>th</sup> JAMBOREE-ON-THE-AIR (JOTA) & 28<sup>th</sup> JAMBOREE-ON-THE-INTERNET (JOTI) on **October 18-20, 2024** at Padada National High School, Northern Paligue, Padada, Davao del Sur.
- 2. **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**. The activity aims to encourage scouts to reach out to other scouts all over the province, the country, and the world through amateur radio and internet connection. This will also include interaction and communication with other cultures and diversities all over the world.
- QUALIFICATIONS. Participating Boy Scouts, Senior Scouts, and Adult Leaders must be currently registered with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, physically fit to undergo strenuous activities, with corresponding parental consent, and must be equipped with camping gear.
- 4. **PARTICIPATION QUOTA**. In order to exercise an effective and efficient learning environment, a ratio of One (1) Unit Leader and Eight (8) Scouts (1:8) is allowed to participate and shall report on October 18, 2024, at 5:00 PM at the venue.
- REGISTRATION FEE. A registration fee of THREE HUNDRED PESOS (P300.00) shall be collected from each participant to defray the costs of materials needed and other administrative expenses.
- 6. WHAT TO BRING. Participants are REQUIRED to bring the following camping items, to wit:
  - Type "A" or "B" Scout Uniform with black leather shoes;
  - Sportswear and personal gear/beddings/tents;
  - · Eating utensils, toiletries, and Medicine/First Aid Kit;
  - · Laptop (optional) and/or Smart Phone with stable internet connection;
  - Food provision for the whole duration of the activity.
- Corresponding service credits and/or compensatory overtime credits (SC/COC) shall be granted to all
  accompanying Adult Leaders and Staff who will participate and serve, respectively during the activity
  as provided for by DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012.
