Subject : **Attendance of Teachers for TM COC2 Training and Learners for TESDA Competency Assessment**

Date : October 21 , 2024

In connection with the implementation of the Joint Memorandum Circulars (JMC) between the Department of Education (DepEd), Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), Commission on Higher Education (CHED), and the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), TESDA Davao del Sur will conduct the following activities aimed at enhancing the teaching and learning competencies in the Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (TVL) track:

- 1. Training Methodology COC 2 (TM1) for Thirty-Six (36) DepEd Teachers:**
TESDA will facilitate the TM1 COC 2 training, which is scheduled to begin on **October 25, 2024**. The teachers endorsed for this training are expected to participate fully throughout the training period. All concerned school heads must ensure that teachers attend the sessions as scheduled. (List of Teachers hereto attached)
- 2. Competency Assessment for Senior High School Learners under the TVL Track:**
TESDA will also conduct Competency Assessments for Senior High School learners who are eligible but are not covered by the Joint Delivery Voucher Program (JDVP). All school heads are required to endorse the names of eligible learners under the TVL Track. These learners will be given the opportunity to undergo the Competency Assessment as part of TESDA's effort to certify their acquired skills.

It is essential that participants are informed promptly to ensure smooth coordination with TESDA Davao del Sur for the proper scheduling and implementation of both the training and the competency assessments.

All concerned are reminded that **all allocated funds for this program must be utilized up to December 31, 2024** only. Failure to use these funds within the given period will result in their reversion to the National Treasury.

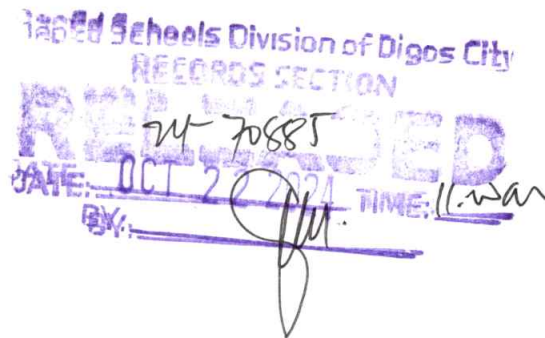

Greetings of peace and good health from TESDA Davao del Sur!

The Department of Education (DepEd), Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), Commission on Higher Education (CHED), and Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) signed two Joint Memorandum Circulars (JMC) to intensify government's commitment to improve the country's education system and to better prepare Filipino graduates for work.

Memorandum No. 09-1786 signed by TESDA XI Regional Director Ashary M. Banto dated September 23, 2024 was issued relative to the implementation of said circulars.

On October 7, 2024 a meeting was called by the TESDA Provincial Office attended by DepEd Digos City and DepEd Davao del Sur Division Office together with CCNTS and PTC-Davao del Sur to discuss the conduct of TM1 COC2 training to 36 DepEd teachers and competency assessments to Senior High School Learners under TVL Track that are not Joint Delivery Voucher Program (JDVP) scholars.

Anent to this, may we kindly request to provide us the following data;

- Endorsed Names of the Thirty Six (36) DepEd Teachers who will undergo Training and Assessment on TM COC 2 (Training to start on October 25, 2024)
- Names of Senior High School Learners under TVL Track duly endorsed by the SDS who are eligible to avail of the Competency Assessment

Moreover, it is important to note that funds allocated for this program must be utilized on or before December 31, 2024. Unutilized funds will be reverted to the National Treasury at the end of this year.
