

Pursuant to Malacañang Proclamation 247 dated September 2, 2002, the month of September of every year is declared as **Development Policy Research Month** (**DPRM**) to promote and draw nationwide awareness on the importance of policy research in the formulation of national development plans, programs, and policies.

Anchoring to this year's theme, "Securing a Future for All by Growing a Resilient Middle Class", or in Filipino, "Pagpapalawak ng Matatag na Middle Class tungo sa Pagtiyak ng Kinabukasan para sa Lahat", activities celebrating the DPRM this coming September will highlight opportunities and challenges in expanding the Filipino middle class in the face of emerging global megatrends that can either accelerate growth of further widen disparities. 




