

#### I. LCI GENERAL CONTEST MECHANICS

- 1. The contest's theme is "PEACE WITHOUT LIMITS".
- 2. The contest is open to students who will be 11, 12, or 13 years of ages on November 15,
- 2024. Eligible birth dates are November 16, 2010 through November 15, 2013
- 3. Artwork must be no smaller than 13 inches by 20 inches (33 centimeters by 50 centimeters) and not larger than 24 inches by 20 inches (50 centimeters by 60 centimeters).
- 4. Do not mat or frame artwork; Only one entry per student per year, and each entry

be the work of only one student;

- 5. All artwork must be the individual student's original creation. Duplication is not accepted;
- 6. All media are accepted. Note: Chalk, charcoal and pastel entries should be sealed with a

fixative spray to prevent smearing. Do not laminate entries;

- 7. Three-dimensional entries will not be accepted. Nothing may be glued, stapled or attached to the artwork in any way;
- 8. The use of lettering or numbering on the front of the poster, in any language, is not allowed. All artist signatures or initials should be written on the back of the poster;
- 9. Artwork should be done on a flexible material so it can be rolled for shipping in a mailing tube. Do not fold poster;
- 10. Expression of the theme, artistic merit and originality are the three criteria used to evaluate

the posters at all judging levels.

11. All entries must be submitted on November 12, 2024 to the district chairperson on Peace Poster
