This is to announce the holding of the 43rd GSP COUNCIL-WIDE CAMP with the theme "Women of Today for the Girls of Tomorrow" to be hosted by Padada Central Elementary School, Padada District, Padada, Davao del Sur from November 28 – December 1, 2024.

QUALIFICATION OF A CAMPER

- 1. Must be a registered Junior /Senior or Cadet Scout
- 2. Must be physically fit
- 3. Can sustain outdoor activities / adventure
- 4. Must have attended a troop or school camp

CAMP FEE

One Thousand Two Hundred (Php.1,200.00) for the following expenses:

- Event t-shirt, Camping program materials, Office supplies, Dinner on November 30, 2024, Camp Equipment and facilities, Camper's guide, Certificates and Group Insurance, Van or Bus rental and other expenses during off-site activities, Electricity and Water bills, Physical Arrangement-ground clearing, Badges, Other operational expenses.
- Food during dinner of November 28, 2024 will be included in the registration.
- Districts and Schools may add budget for the meals and snacks of the participants

Star Holiday – November 30, 2024, Event fee is P 250.00 only

Participants are Star Scouts (grade 1 to grade 3) to be chaperoned by their Troop Leaders or parents.

Attire - GSP Official Uniform during opening ceremony. Girls are requested to bring their camp uniform and extra t-shirt for the games and other activities.

Troop Leadership Course – Nov. 16, 23, 30 and December 1, 2024 Event fee - 1,200.00

The venue of training for November 16 and 23, 2024 will be at the GSP Conference Hall, while November 30 and December 1, 2024 will be at Padada Central Elementary School.

Attire: GSP Official Uniform during ceremonies and alternate uniform during Sessions and outdoor activities.

ARRIVAL IN CAMP

- 1. Campers are expected to arrive at camp in the morning of Thursday, November 28, 2024.
- 2. Upon arrival, the camp hostess shall guide the delegates to their Camp area. The head of the delegation shall proceed to the registration center and register their delegates. After the registration, proceed to the Camp BM for the release of supplies. Please bring the receipt as proof of payment.
- 3. The camp hostess will guide to your room assignment which will be used by the campers and shall put up their tents. Campers must sleep at the scout tent.
- 4. Campers must bring their own patrol sleeping tents and fly tents.

DISTRICT DELEGATION

A minimum of 40 girls per district/High school. A ratio of 2 adult chaperone on every 8 girls, but no limit to the maximum.

Award will be presented to:

First 3 highest delegation – Award and Token Others above the minimum - token and certificate

HEALTH PROTOCOLS/ PARENTAL CONSENT

- 1. The campers must submit a duly accomplished **HEALTH EXAMINATION FORM** together with a PARENT CONSENT FORM - attached
- 2. There will be an infirmary station at the camp for the physical re-examination of the campers. Districts are reminded not to bring campers with health concerns/issues.

FOOD MANAGEMENT AND OTHER SERVICES

- 1. Districts/Schools shall prepare and cook their own meals in camp based on the proposed menu in the Campers Guide. The camp management will provide the food of the camper's dinner on November 28, 2024 as part of the registration.
- 2. Other Services of the camp-Trading Post, Canteen, Bottled/Gallon water for sale and many others.
- 3. Campers are requested to bring their individual refillable water bottle or tumbler, eating utensils and a set of cooking utensils

THINGS TO BRING

Will be sent through your district and school coordinators after the finalization of Program of Activities.

ACCOMODATION

Every delegation will be provided a room in case of heavy rain. Girls are requested to sleep in their tents. As a token of gratitude to the teacher in charge of the room, kindly bring a present/gift to be given to the teachers. In addition, room occupants are requested to clean the room before leaving.

PRE-CAMP

Districts and Schools are requested to conduct a pre-camp training of their girls on November 16 and 23, 2024 to prepare the girls and orient them the things to do while in camp.

SERVICE CREDITS

Service Credits will be granted to teachers and compensatory overtime credits (COC) shall likewise be granted to commissioners and non-teaching staff participants.
