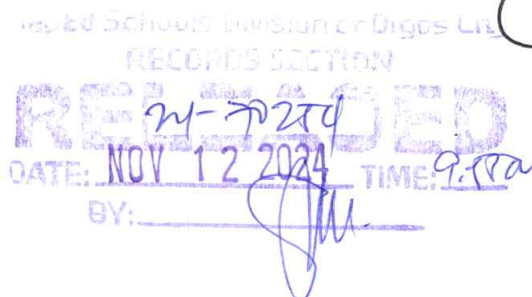
This Office interposes no objection to the above-mentioned activity provided that the participation of DepEd Personnel is voluntary in nature and no government funds shall be utilized.

Subject: **2nd REGIONAL SCOUT VENTURE CAMP & 2nd REGIONAL ROVER MOOT**

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines – Davao del Sur Council is organizing a contingent to the 2nd Regional Scout Venture Camp & 2nd Regional Rover Moot on December 20-23, 2024 at Maragusan Sports Complex, Maragusan, Davao de Oro.
2. **AIMS AND OBJECTIVE.** The Camp aims to provide opportunities for Scouts to practice and enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potential, and discover and act upon their strengths through challenging, adventurous and experimental learning activities.
3. **QUALIFICATIONS.** The following are the qualifications for participation.
 - 3.1. A Scout is expected to have leadership potentials, sufficient camping experience, must have parental consent and must be:
 - Registered as a Senior Scout or Rover Scout with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
 - 13 years old and above but not over 26 years old;
 - Fully equipped with camping gears;
 - Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician; and
 - Should have parental consent for scouts aged below 18 years old.
 - 3.2. Adult Leader must have the maturity and clarity about his role and must be:
 - Registered as an Adult Leader with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
 - Trained as an Outfit Advisor, Asst. Outfit Advisor, Circle Manager, or Asst. Circle Manager;
 - Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician; and
 - Fully Equipped with camping gears;
4. **REGISTRATION FEE.** A registration fee of ONE THOUSAND PESOS (**₱1,000.00**) shall be collected from each participant. The registration fee must be paid to the council on or before **December 5, 2024, Thursday**.
5. **TRANSPORTATION.** All participating delegates shall provide their own transportation to and from the Jamboree Site and are advised to submit their Itinerary to the Local Council for record and reference purposes. Furthermore, all participants are advised to report at the Jamboree Site not later than **8:00 AM of Friday, 20 December 2024**, and will only be cleared to leave the camp on **Monday, 23 December 2024**.
6. **FOOD PROVISION.** All participants must provide for their own food and other basic necessities that will be sufficient throughout the entire duration of the event. Wet and dry markets will be made available near the Camp Site.

7. **WHAT TO BRING.** Participants are REQUIRED to bring the following camping items, to wit:
- Type "A" Scout Uniform with black leather shoes;
 - Sportswear and personal gears/beddings/tents;
 - Eating utensils and toiletries;
 - Medicine/First Aid Kit;
 - Duly filled-up application form with parental consent and medical certificate.
8. Corresponding compensatory overtime and/or service credits shall be granted to all accompanying Adult Leaders as provided for by DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012.
9. For immediate information and widest dissemination to all concerned.
