In reference to Boy Scout of the Philippines (BSP) Council Office Memorandum No. 25, s. 2024 dated November 5, 2024, the field is hereby informed of the conduct of the 33rd Asia-Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree on December 14 – 21, 2025 at Kainomayan Scout Camp in the Municipality of Botolan, Province of Zambales, Philippines, with the theme: “Be Prepared: Scouts for Peace and Sustainable Development.

This Office interposes no objection to the above-mentioned activity provided that the participation of DepEd Personnel is voluntary in nature and no government funds shall be utilized.

Corresponding compensatory overtime/service credits (COC/SC) shall be granted by providing 3-day service credits to all attendees for services rendered on two Sundays (December 14, 21, 2025) and one Saturday (December 15, 2025) as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 013, s. 2024 on “Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers.”

All other details of the activity are found on the enclosures for ready reference.

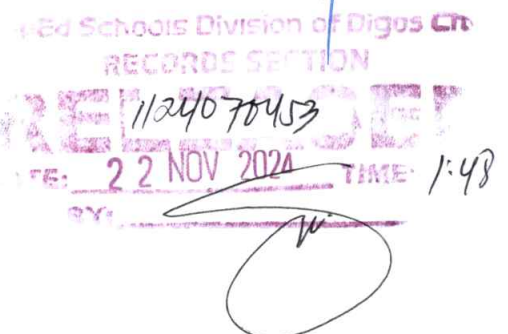

Subject: **33rd ASIA-PACIFIC REGIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE**




1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines – Davao del Sur Council is organizing a contingent to the **33rd Asia-Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree** on **December 14-21, 2025** at Kainomayan Scout Camp in the **Municipality of Botolan, Province of Zambales, Philippines**, with the theme: "Be Prepared: Scouts for Peace and Sustainable Development."
2. **AIMS AND OBJECTIVE.** The Camp aims to provide opportunities for Scouts to practice and enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potential, and discover and act upon their strengths through challenging, adventurous and experimental learning activities.
3. **QUALIFICATIONS.** The following are the qualifications for participation.
 - 3.1. A Scout is expected to have leadership potentials, sufficient camping experience, must have parental consent and must be:
 - Registered as a Boy Scout or Senior Scout with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
 - 12 years old and above but not over 18 years old;
 - Fully equipped with camping gears;
 - Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician
 - 3.2. Adult Leader must have the maturity and clarity about his role and must be:
 - Registered as an Adult Leader with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
 - Trained as a Unit Leader, and preferable an ATC graduate;
 - Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician; and
 - Fully Equipped with camping gears;
4. **REGISTRATION FEE.** A registration fee of ONE THOUSAND PESOS (**₱1,000.00**) shall be collected from each participant. The registration fee must be paid to the council on or before **January 30, 2025, Thursday**.
5. **TRANSPORTATION.** All participating delegates shall provide their own transportation to and from the Jamboree Site and are advised to submit their Itinerary to the Local Council for record and reference purposes. Furthermore, all participants are advised to report at the Jamboree Site not later than **13 December 2025**, and will only be cleared to leave the camp after the Grand Closing Ceremonies.
6. **FOOD PROVISION.** All participants must provide for their own food and other basic necessities that will be sufficient throughout the entire duration of the event. Wet and dry markets will be made available near the Camp Site.

7. **WHAT TO BRING.** Participants are REQUIRED to bring the following camping items, to wit:
- Type "A" Scout Uniform with black leather shoes;
 - Sportswear and personal gears/beddings/tents;
 - Eating utensils and toiletries;
 - Medicine/First Aid Kit;
 - Duly filled-up application form with parental consent and medical certificate.
8. Corresponding compensatory overtime and/or service credits shall be granted to all accompanying Adult Leaders as provided for by DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012.
9. For immediate information and widest dissemination to all concerned.
