1. Gulayan sa Paaralan Program under DepEd Memorandum No. 293 S. 2007 was established in coordination with the Department of Agriculture to help address hunger and malnutrition in the country. As one of the hunger mitigation and poverty alleviation schemes, it helps promote food security and economic stability for affected families.
2. The program seeks to promote:
 - raise the level of public consciousness on the health and nutritional dimension as well as economic benefits of establishing School, household and community gardens;
 - establish school gardens to serve as the food basket/main source of commodities to sustain supplementary feeding;
 - intensify production of selected varieties of fruits and vegetables that are rich sources of protein, calorie, vitamins and minerals to improve child nutrition;
 - showcase small-scale food production models in schools for the households/community to replicate purposely to promote family food security; and
 - inculcate among the studentry the values of good health and nutrition, industry, love of labor and caring for others.

In relation to this, an evaluation of the program will be conducted by the Office of the Provincial Agriculture on November 20, 2024. The schools above mentioned are instructed to prepare the needed documents and presentations for the said evaluation.
