AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE GUIDELINES IN THE CELEBRATION OF CHRISTMAS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

- the Philippines, one of the six predominantly Christian countries in A boasts the earliest, longest, and perhaps, the most colorful Christmas season in world. Anidst the worst calamities, crises, losses, and pandemic, we Filipinos alw carry resilient spirits and joyful hearts in relebrating Christmas and the holiseason.
- The first Christmas set the pattern for how Jesus Christ lived His whole here on earth: with humility, simplicity, and obedience. Every Christmas is invitation and a challenge for humanity to imitate and imbibe these virtues.
- To this end, the whole Department of Education (DepEd) community is ur, to strive for a genuine celebration of hope, unity, and service for others ex Christmas season. Celebrations in public schools and DepEd central and field offi should be simple yet meaningful, keeping in mind the true spirit of the season if the austerity collect for by the difficult economic times.
- In line with the foregoing, the following guidelines should be observed:
 - are voluntary. No fearner or Deped personnel should be forcer contribute, participate, or use their money for the celebration;
 - No learner shall be excluded from joining the Christmas celebration reason of their failure to give the voluntary contribution or alisence prepared gift;
 - c. Celebrations in schools and in DepEd offices, as far as practicable, she simple yet meaningful. Christmas party themes should not resu expenses that will become a burden on parents, students, and Depersonnel;
 - Contributions for celebrations in schools or offices, whether in cash kind, should be strictly voluntary.

- Old Christmas decors should be recycled, purchase of new decors an encouraged. No learner or Deped personnel will be required to make de specifically for a party.;
- Christmas parties in schools may be organized within class hours to as it does not interfere with the scheduled lesson plans intended taught to the students.
- g. The conduct of Christmas get-togethers and other similar year activities should not compromise the provision of departmental service

- DepEd personnel should be reminded that solicitations, whether in ca in kind, are not allowed for Christmas parties or holiday relebrations.
- 5. The provisions of this Under cover all Depild schools and offices in country.
- 5. Schools Division Offices may issue additional guidelines based on their leastoms and traditions, subject to the abovementioned guidelines.
- 7. Private schools community learning centers, as well as state/1 universities and colleges (SUCs/LUCs) may choose to adopt the provisions of DO as basis in the conduct of their own Christmas parties or celebrations.
