In accordance with the 2nd Indorsement from the Regional Director, Allan G. Farnazo, Director IV, this Office informs the concerned personnel of the Regional Office's order for the Schools Division of Digos City to effect the immediate TRANSFER of the Cavite Bible Baptist Academy - Digos Branch learners to public schools following failure of the school to secure classrooms and other vital school facilities, and for utilizing a non-prescribed curriculum.

Relative to this, it is hereby reiterated that the Schools Division Office shall:

- 1. Ensure that the affected students will only be transferred to a public school near their residences;
- 2. Properly inform the learners, their parents, guardians, etc. relative to their transfer;
- 3. Guarantee the smooth registration of the students in the Learner Information System (LIS);
- 4. Provide technical assistance to CBBA-Digos Branch; and
- 5. Perform other actions deemed necessary to undertake.

The following Division personnel are hereby instructed to carry out the following tasks in the implementation of the Regional Order:

- 1. SGOD and CID Chiefs oversee the overall implementation;
- 2. Private Schools Focal Person leads the implementation and prepares letter to the private school concerned;







- 3. PSDS concerned and other PSDSs assist the Private Schools Focal in the transfer of the learners;
- 4. Planning Officer ensures the transfer-registration of the learners in the LIS;
- 5. SMM&E Personnel take charge of the documentation and the preparation of a narrative report; and
- 6. Division Information Officer posts to DepEd Digos City fb page that the school concerned is no longer operating.


