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

The Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) hereby reiterates the directive for all field offices and schools to immediately disseminate DepEd Order No. 22, s. 2024, *Revised Guidelines on Class and Work Suspension in Schools during Disasters and Emergencies*, to all school personnel, learners, and parents.

As part of the Department of Education's commitment to ensuring the safety and security of learners and personnel, it is critical that all stakeholders are fully informed about the provisions of this order. The guidelines aim to protect the well-being of school communities while ensuring the continuity of education, especially in areas vulnerable to disasters and emergencies.

In addition, the DRRMS urges that if there are any gatherings such as Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) meetings, the discussion of DO 22, s. 2024 should be included as one of the agenda items. This will help ensure that parents are also informed and aware of the guidelines for class and work suspension during disasters and emergencies.

All field offices and schools are expected to prioritize the prompt and thorough dissemination of this order. Immediate action is necessary to ensure that all relevant parties are educated on the guidelines and prepared to respond accordingly in case of emergencies.
