



CONCEPT PAPER

EVENT TITLE:

3RD NFJPIA-RXIC ABM CUP

II. THEME:

The Grand Clockwork: Guiding Scholars Through the

Cosmos of Knowledge

III. RATIONALE

The 3rd NFJPIA-RXIC ABM Cup is an annual event hosted by the National Federation of Junior Philippine Institute of Accountants – Region XI Council (NFJPIA-RXIC). It is dedicated to the region's Senior High School ABM students. The event aims to provide students with an opportunity to (1) showcase their proficiency in solving theoretical and computational problems in Business Mathematics and Fundamentals of Accounting and (2) discover the champion within themselves. This experience will equip them for the next chapter of their academic life: college.

IV. SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- To promote academic excellence among students, fostering a deeper understanding of accounting.
- To provide students with the opportunity to test their knowledge in a friendly, fun, and competitive atmosphere.
- To assist participants in discovering their strengths and weaknesses in various Accountancy-related subjects through the academic competitions.





- To enhance the visibility of NFJPIA Region XI on a broader scale, ensuring awareness among Region XI ABM students about the organization's existence.
- To foster camaraderie and introduce the NFJPIA community to potential future members.

V. SCOPE, COVERAGE, AND ELIGIBILITY

The 3rd NFJPIA-RXIC ABM Cup is open to all students in the field of Accountancy, Business, and Management (ABM) within the region. The schools shall send a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of ten (10) students to compete, as the event will accept up to ten representatives from each school in Region XI. The event expects to cater a total of five hundred participants overall, only accepting a total of two hundred participants from Davao del Norte, Davao de Oro, and Davao Oriental (Bracket 1) and three hundred participants from Davao del Norte, Davao de Oro, and Davao Oriental (Bracket 2). Therefore, only the first five hundred registrants can join the Elimination Round. The event will collect a registration fee of Php 350.00 per student, covering food for the elimination and semi-final rounds, as well as materials, such as but not limited to answer sheets and questionnaires, to be used by each participant in the competition.

As part of the registration process and requirements, the Adviser or teacher-in-charge is required to complete the master list using the provided link by creating a copy instead of directly editing the sheet. The necessary documents must then be submitted through the provided email addresses.

Furthermore, the eligibility of the participants will be carefully evaluated. Only enrolled SHS ABM students for the school year 2024-2025 are allowed to





register for the NFJPIA-RXIC 3RD ABM CUP. There will be no minimum high school average grade requirement for the participants.

The Regional ABM Cup 2025's coverage shall include the following topics: (1)
Business Mathematics; (2) Fundamental of Accountancy, Business, and
Management 1; and (3) Fundamental of Accountancy, Business, and
Management 2.

VI. SUCCESS INDICATORS

Pre-Event

- a. Obtain a recommendation letter from the Department of Education, the government agency responsible for overseeing basic education in the Philippines.
- b. Get the contact information of at least sixty percent (60%) of the participating schools coming from different Senior High School Institutions (both public and private) in Region XI, a month before the event.
- c. A week prior the event, there should be at least two (2) invitational messages, thru Facebook and Gmail accounts of the organization, to be present on the events.
- d. Confirm at least 75 registered participants at least a week before the event.

In-Event

- e. Achieve a minimum of 75 actual participants in attendance during the elimination round.
- f. Ensure the event (Elimination, Semi-Final, and Final Round) runs smoothly according to the program flow with only minimal delays.









Post-Event

g. Get feedback from at least fifty-five percent (55%) of the participants through post-event evaluation forms.
