Subject: CONDUCT OF THREE-DAY SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON TECHNO-PLATFORMS FOR EDUCATORS: REVOLUTIONIZING CURRICULUM PLANNING, TEACHING AND ASSESSMENT

Date : May 29, 2025

This Office announces the conduct of a three-day Seminar-Workshop on “Techno-Platforms for Educators: Revolutionizing Curriculum Planning, Teaching and Assessment” on June 4–6, 2025 at The Ritz Hotel at Garden Oasis, Porras St., Davao City. This activity is part of the Human Resource Development Program for Teachers and Educational Leaders.

The seminar-workshop aims to enhance participants’ capabilities in using Artificial Intelligence (AI) platforms for curriculum planning, instructional material development, and assessment design aligned with the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs). Participants are expected to apply these technologies in their respective roles to improve instructional quality and support effective teaching and learning outcomes.

Participants are advised that the first meal to be served is breakfast on Day 1, with hotel accommodation provided until Day 3 in the afternoon, concluding with afternoon snacks. Additionally, all participants must bring their own laptops and internet devices to address potential bandwidth limitations. Only teachers from schools verified by Khan Academy are eligible to attend.

All participants are required to:

- Carry a laptop with charger and extension cord;
- Bring other necessary materials for finalization;
- Internet devices (for in case); and
- Necessary personal provisions for a 3-day stay.



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The board, lodging, and meals shall be charged against HRD PSF subject to current budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Meanwhile, travel and other incidental expenses shall be charged against the school MOOE for participating public school teachers and school heads, and Division MOOE for division personnel, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Service credits will be granted to teaching personnel pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 ("Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers"), and compensatory time-off credits will be provided to non-teaching personnel in accordance with Civil Service Commission (CSC) Resolution No. 98-404 and Memorandum Circular No. 41, s. 1998, which provides guidelines on the use of compensatory time-off for services rendered beyond regular working hours. The complete list of participants, members of the program management team / technical working group are attached as Enclosure 1.

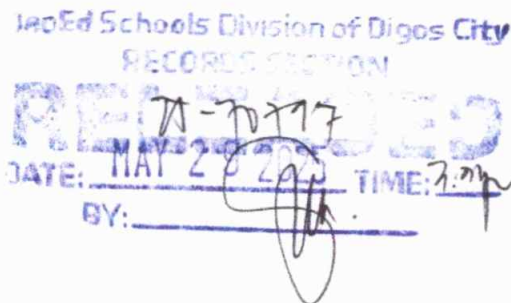
