MATHEMATICS ASSESSMENT (RMA)**

The Department of Education (DepEd) has adopted the National Learning Recovery Program (NLRP) through DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2023, which includes the need to enhance learners' numeracy skills and contribute to the overall learning recovery efforts in the education sector.

In support of the nationwide implementation of the NLRP and its goal to enhance learners' numeracy skills, the Schools Division Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, will conduct training-workshop on the Administration of Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA) on June 25, 2025 (Wednesday) at Megas World Function Hall, Aurora Extension corner Aquino Road, Digos City.

The Teacher-Trainers and the Division Technical Working Group (TWG) are scheduled to convene for a face-to-face meeting on June 9, 2025 (Monday), from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The venue will be announced through the TWG and Speakers' group chat. In addition, a brief virtual meeting will be held via Google Meet on Wednesday, June 4, 2026. The meeting link will also be shared in the group chat.


The distribution list of participants from the elementary and secondary levels, division personnel, the Division Technical Working Group (TWGs), and teacher-trainers is provided in Enclosure 1 of this Division Memorandum.


In accordance with existing guidelines, teaching personnel shall be granted vacation service credits for services rendered during summer break, weekends, and holidays pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, while non-teaching personnel shall be entitled to Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) for services rendered during weekends and holidays in accordance with CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 and CSC Memorandum Circular No. 41, s. 1998.

Travel expense incurred by school heads and teachers shall be charged against the School MOOE/Local Funds, while the travel expense of SDO personnel shall be charged against the Division MOOE, and the food expense of all participants shall be charged against the Program Support Funds (PSF) for the Administration of the Rapid Mathematics Assessment and Printing of RMA Tools and Mathematics Supplementary

Learning Materials, all subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
