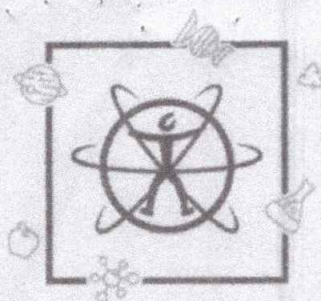

This year, our organization has selected two (2) student-leaders from each region all over the country to be a representative of their region and serve as a member of their respective Regional Councils.

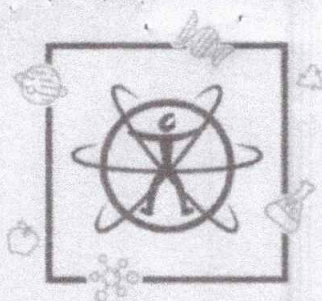

- II. - V. The target participants for the 2025 NLEAD are selected high school students (Grades 10-12) with two (2) representatives per region, upon assessment. The eligible applicants by the organizers. The event promotes the development of essential leadership skills among student leaders and the sustained growth of the science clubbing movement. By offering comprehensive training, the event aims to empower young leaders to effectively serve their communities and advance the public understanding of science, technology, society, and the environment (PUSTE).
