The Office also extends its congratulations to the senior and cadet scouts who have successfully completed the one-year Community Development Project. Your efforts have made



Attire are as follows:


- Ceremonies – official uniform

School Coordinators are requested to register/confirm their participation to the said event for the preparation of food, Chief GS Medal Manual and other training materials.


