1. The SBFP is an excellent mechanism for select intervention in the school-age learners as it offers an opportunity not only for enhancing nutrition but also for improving educational outcomes. The School-Based Feeding program for the Schools Division Office of Digos City provides Nutritious food products (NFP) and milk components, to all identified severely wasted and wasted elementary school public learners.
2. In this connection the field is hereby informed of the School-Based Feeding Program commencement on July 14, 2025 and the school is advised to have a launching activity of the School-Based Feeding program within the week July 14-18, 2025.




