1. The Department of Education (DepEd) in the Philippines conducts school-based deworming activities in partnership with the Department of Health to deworm elementary and secondary public school learners (DM No.80, s. 2015) as reference in relation to School-based deworming programs.
2. The following are the objectives of this program:
 - a. Reduce the prevalence of soil-transmitted helminthiasis (STH) among school children/learners.
 - b. To improve the overall health and well-being of learners, contributing to better learning and performance in school.
 - c. To promote hygiene and sanitation practices that prevents STH infection.

All BFP recipients are advised to take deworming drugs to ensure they can absorb the full nutritional benefits of the program's meals.

4. Parental consent is required for deworming Administration No Parents' Consent No deworming administration.
5. District nurse/s is advised to monitor the deworming implementation in the school level.




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6. In case of adverse event following intake (AEFI) of deworming drugs, you may contact your Baranggay midwives/BHW and District nurse/s.
7. Included in the Memorandum is the flow of the deworming activity for your ready reference.
8. After the Deworming Activity the School is required to submit an accomplishment report on August 06, 2025 to your district nurse/s.

<p>a. Prepare Master list of School learners</p> <p>b. Ensure availability of deworming and supportive drugs</p> <p><u>Remember the following:</u></p> <p>Recommended Drug for Deworming treatment</p> <p>Albendazole 400mg chewable flavoured tablet</p> <p><u>Precautionary Measures on Deworming Administration</u></p>	<p>-Clean drinking water should be available at the school treatment day.</p> <p>-Each learner shall receive one tablet of deworming drug.</p> <p>- The names of the children who are absent during the deworming day should be recorded by the teacher and these children should be treated when they return to school. Children who are ill on treatment day should not receive drugs, to prevent the potential misperception that the deworming medicine caused the illness. They can take the deworming drugs later when they are well again.</p> <p>In case of adverse event following intake of the deworming medicines/drugs notify your Baranggay Midwives/BHW and district nurse/s</p>	<p>The class adviser shall make sure that all children listed in the Master list with Parents' Consent were given deworming drugs.</p> <p>Submission of Accomplishment Report to the Division Office will be collected by your respective district Nurse/s</p>
Albendazole is not recommended if the child:		
-is seriously ill		
-has high fever		
-is experiencing abdominal pain;		



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Diarrhea;or		
-Previously suffered hypersensitivity to drug		
Note: before giving the Albendazole 400mg make sure that the school learners are on full stomach
