

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Considering the prioritized themes and issues, the following are the thematic areas for Multidisciplinary Research:

1. Education Innovation, Humanities, Social Sciences and Business;

4. Engineering & Technology

ABSTRACT FORMAT

1. The Abstract (a 150-300 word informative digest of objectives, methodology, and significant findings of the paper, single spaced with 3-5 key words)
2. Abstract shall be submitted through the link: <http://nreach2025.urs.edu.ph>
3. The authors will be notified for the status of their submitted abstract.

FORMAT FOR RESEARCH PAPER REPORT

The paper should be typed double-spaced in A4 paper using the Arial font with a font size of 11 and with a 2.54 cm margin on all sides. The paper should include the title, author/s, abstract (not more than 300 words), introduction, objectives, review of literature, conceptual framework, theoretical framework, methodology (research design, participants, procedure, & data analysis), results and discussion, implications/recommendations, acknowledgment, and references. All pages of the paper should be numbered consecutively and should not be more than 30 pages.

PAPER PRESENTATION FORMAT

Ten (10) minutes will be allocated for the presentation and another ten (10) minutes for the Q&A Portion. Maximum of ten (10) slides only and should contain the following:

- Title, Proponents, Duration, Budget, Implementing/Collaborating Agency
- Introduction





- Objectives (in bullet form)
- Conceptual Framework
- Methodology (by Objective)
- Results and Discussions (in bullet form)
- Implications and Recommendations (in bullet form)

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Anchored on the global themes and seeking to address prioritized issues, the thematic areas in Extension are the following:

1. Food Production & Safety and Sustainable Agriculture;
2. Social Equity / Gender and Development / Poverty Alleviation;
3. Environmental Preservation

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY FORMAT

1. The Executive Summary (a 150-300 word informative digest of objectives, methodology, and significant findings of the paper, single spaced with 3-5 key words)
2. Executive Summary shall be submitted through the link:
<http://nreach2025.urs.edu.ph>
3. The authors will be notified for the status of their submitted abstract/ executive summary.

FORMAT FOR EXTENSION PAPER REPORT

The paper should be typed double-spaced in A4 paper using the Times New Roman with a font size of 11 and a 2.54 cm margin on all sides, numbered sequentially. The paper should not be more than 30 pages and include the Program/Project Title, Faculty Extensionists, Duration, Rationale, Objectives, Methodology, Development Framework, Strategies of Implementation, Phases of Development, Outcomes/Results of the Project, Conclusion, Recommendation, Further Plan, References.

PAPER PRESENTATION FORMAT

1. Each presenter is given ten (10) minutes to discuss the highlights of the project.
2. There will be a ten (10) minute time allocation for the Open Forum to give the participants an opportunity to exchange insights with the presenters.
3. The power point presentation must bear the following:
 - 3.1 Program/Project Title
 - Faculty Extensionists
 - Duration
 - Cooperating Agency
 - 3.2 Rationale
 - 3.3 Objectives



- 3.4 Methodology
 - Development Framework
 - Strategies of Implementation
 - Phases of Development
- 3.5 Outcomes/Results of the Project
- 3.6 Conclusion
- 3.7 Recommendation
- 3.8 Further Plan
- 3.9 References

POSTER GUIDELINES
(for both research and extension)

1. The poster must be printed in tarpaulin form to be submitted a day before the conference proper.
2. Its size should be 30" x 40" (Portrait), using Arial font for the text, 24 points for the body and 48 points for the title.
3. The information to be included are the following:
 - I. Title
 - II. Rationale
 - III. Objectives
 - IV. Conceptual Framework
 - V. Methodology
 - VI. Results and Discussion
 - VII. Conclusions
