The need for practical support in managing diverse learner needs, particularly for learners with Autism Spectrum Disorder, Hearing Impairment, and Visual Impairment is increasingly evident.

Teachers have expressed challenges such as managing behavioral manifestations of autism, maintaining classroom engagement for learners with sensory sensitivities, and adapting lessons for learners with limited hearing or vision.

To help address these concerns, a comprehensive training workshop titled "Equipping Grade 1 Teachers to Support Learners with Autism, Hearing Impairment (HI), and Visual Impairment (VI)" will be held on June 12, 2025, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM at the Division Conference Hall, Digos City.

The workshop is designed to enhance teachers' skills and confidence in effectively supporting these learners.


