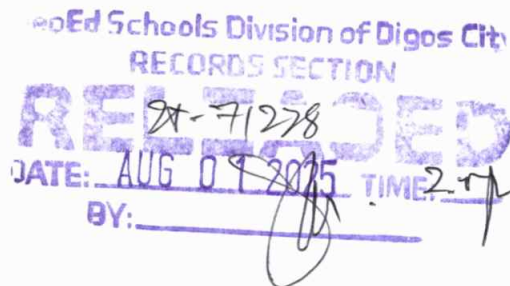

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 92**

**DIRECTING STRONGER PARTICIPATION AND  
INVOLVEMENT OF ALL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES AND  
INSTRUMENTALITIES IN THE OBSERVANCE OF THE  
ASSOCIATION OF SOUTHEAST ASIAN NATIONS (ASEAN)  
MONTH**

**WHEREAS**, Proclamation No. 282 (s. 2017) declared the month of August of every year as the "ASEAN Month" and enjoined all government agencies, especially the Department of Foreign Affairs, Department of Education, Department of the Interior and Local Government, Department of Tourism, Department of Trade and Industry, and the Commission on Higher Education, to initiate and implement programs and activities to help generate consciousness and public support in promoting awareness of the ASEAN;

**WHEREAS**, during the 43<sup>rd</sup> ASEAN Summit in September 2023, the ASEAN leaders agreed that the Philippines will assume the Chairpersonship of ASEAN and host the ASEAN Summit in 2026 (ASEAN 2026);

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order No. 17 (s. 2024) constituted the ASEAN National Organizing Council (NOC) to facilitate the planning, implementation, and monitoring of programs, activities, and projects for the Philippines' hosting of ASEAN 2026;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to further promote and heighten awareness of the ASEAN, provide preparatory activities for the public in anticipation of the Philippines' hosting of ASEAN in 2026, and highlight the importance of ASEAN and regional partnerships; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 17, Article VII of the Constitution vests in the President the power of control over all the executive departments, bureaus and offices, and the mandate to ensure the faithful execution of laws;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the following are hereby ordered:

The ASEAN NOC member-agencies are hereby directed to conduct enhanced programs and activities for the commemoration of the ASEAN Month in August 2025. The programs and activities shall be aligned with the theme "Inclusivity and Sustainability," to reflect Malaysia's ASEAN Chairpersonship theme for 2025 and ASEAN's shared commitment to regional peace, security, stability, and prosperity within an inclusive and sustainable framework.

In this regard, the ASEAN NOC member-agencies, through the Office of the Director General for Operations, are hereby directed to submit a report on the programs and activities to be conducted during the 2025 ASEAN Month, within fifteen (15) days from the issuance of this Circular. Further, the Presidential Communications Office is also directed to implement effective measures to inform and encourage public support, and to ensure that both the public and the private sectors are made aware of said programs and activities.

All national government agencies and instrumentalities, including government-owned or -controlled corporations, government financial institutions, and state universities and colleges, are hereby directed to render full support and participation in the programs and activities during the 2025 ASEAN Month, including the recital of the ASEAN Anthem during flag-raising ceremonies for the entire month of August 2025. For this purpose, the heads of all national government agencies and instrumentalities shall ensure that the ASEAN Anthem, which is annexed to this Circular, is properly disseminated within their respective offices.

Local government units, non-government organizations, and the private sector are hereby encouraged to engage in appropriate initiatives in support of the programs and activities for the 2025 ASEAN Month.

The funding requirements for the implementation of this Circular shall be charged against the available appropriations of the concerned agencies, subject to pertinent budgeting, accounting, and auditing laws, rules, and regulations.

This Circular shall take effect immediately.
