

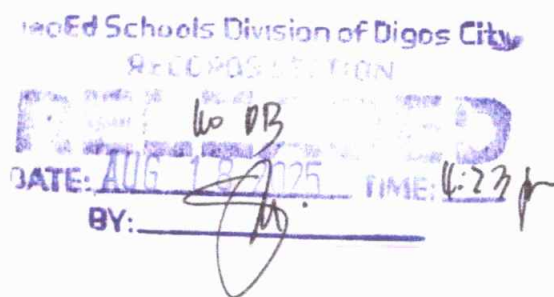
Participation in activities that fall on September 6-8, 2025, shall be voluntary. Learners may participate in the weekend activity only if accompanied by their teacher.
