INSTITUTIONAL ASSESSMENT FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL-TVL TRACK IN

PREPARATION FOR NATIONAL COMPETENCY ASSESSMENT

In reference to DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2025 on the Guidelines on the Implementation of Quality-Assured Assessment for the National Certification of Learners in the Senior High School Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (TVL) Track and the Expansion of the Number of Competency Assessors, this Office hereby directs the SHS-TVL School Heads, TVL Focals, and Specialization Teachers to inform all concerned about the upcoming institutional assessment for the Senior High School TVL Track.

This assessment is part of the preparation for the National Competency Assessment of Grade-12 learners and will be conducted in two phases:

• 1st Semester: October 6–10, 2025

• 2nd Semester: February 16-20, 2026

The objectives of this institutional assessment are as follows:

- a) Evaluate the readiness and competency of Senior High School TVL Grade-12 students in line with the National Competency Standards.
- b) Ensure the alignment of school-based assessment with national standards for TVL tracks.
- c) Prepare Grade-12 students for the upcoming National Competency Assessment.

Guidelines and Procedures:

a) Preparation of Students

School Heads and Specialization Teachers shall ensure Grade-12 learners' readiness, ensuring the safe and proper conduct of the institutional assessment. The school shall also provide the necessary tools, equipment, and consumables needed for the conduct of the institutional assessment, chargeable against School MOOE in accordance with DepEd Order





No. 13, s. 2016, (Implementing Guidelines on the Direct Release and Use of Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses [MOOE] Allocations of Schools). The overseer/evaluator shall be designated to ensure that the conduct of the institutional assessment is carried out in compliance with established standards, provide objective evaluation of processes, validate results, and recommend appropriate interventions to further improve assessment practices.

b) Assessment Tools:

The Self-Assessment Guide and standardized assessment tools shall be utilized for institutional assessment. TVL teachers are enjoined to strictly follow the Training Regulations and National Competency-Based Assessment Criteria.

c) Schedule and Venue:

Schools shall strictly observe the schedule of the institutional assessment during specialization periods. Concerned School Heads must ensure that classes are properly managed and remain undisrupted, in compliance with DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith."

d) Assessment Results:

Schools are required to submit the official results of the institutional assessment to the Division Office within five (5) working days after their conduct of institutional assessment for consolidation, validation, and further analysis.

e) Support and Monitoring:

The Schools Division Office (SDO) shall provide continuous technical assistance and close monitoring during the conduct of the institutional assessment to ensure alignment with standards. Learners assessed as "not yet competent" shall be provided with a structured Training Plan to address gaps.
