In reference to the invitation from the Council for the Restoration of Filipino Values (CRFV), this Office informs the field of the conduct of the Values Restoration Program (VRP) Capacity Building XI on November 18-20, 2025, at Tagaytay Country Hotel, Tagaytay City and via Zoom and FB Live for online participants.

The training aims to deepen participants' understanding on moral and ethical leadership and to capacitate Values Restoration Officers (VROs), advocates, and champions in promoting good governance and integrity in public service. Participants will also earn a certificate equivalent to 24 leadership training hours.

# VALUES RESTORATION PROGRAM (VRP) CAPACITY BUILDING XI TRAINING DESIGN

#### Course Description

The VRP Capacity Building XI is a values-based learning event designed to empower values champions to become influential agents of change. It aims to deepen participants' understanding of their role in rebuilding a values-driven society and equip them with practical, transformative strategies to address current national concerns by translating values into tangible, positive actions.

#### Target Participants

This program is for Values Restoration Officers (VROs), values advocates, and values champions committed to championing integrity and ethical leadership in public service. The training is also open to managers, supervisors, and anyone dedicated to fostering a values-driven culture within their respective agencies.

#### Objectives

By the end of this learning event, participants will be able to:

- 1. Recall the fundamental principles of the Values Restoration Program and its significance in nation-building, particularly in the face of ongoing national issues.
- 2. Analyze the contemporary challenges to integrity and good governance and their impact on public trust.
- 3. Synthesize collaborative strategies to create a ripple effect of positive change, championing the Values Restoration Program as a vital tool for ethical leadership and national transformation.

#### Content

This training is structured to guide participants through a transformative journey, beginning with foundational principles and culminating in actionable strategies for nation-building. The sessions are designed to build upon each other, ensuring a comprehensive and impactful learning experience.

#### Keynote Message: ReBuilding the Nation Through Values

#### Session 1: Moral Infrastructure: Laying the Foundation for Nation-Building

- The principle of moral infrastructure: a concept in which values serve as the foundational bedrock of a society's operational framework.
- · Recall the ethical and moral core values of the Filipino nation.

#### Session 2: The Social Contract and Ethical Governance

- · Analyze the implicit contract between public servants and the nation.
- Apply the principles of social contract—including integrity, accountability, and transparency—to real-world scenarios in public service.

# Session 3: The Blueprint for Restoration: A Values-Based Approach

- Explore the principles of a values-based blueprint or model for restoring public trust.
- Identify key patterns and best practices for applying these principles to governance, particularly in critical governmental processes such as resource allocation and public acquisition.

#### Session 4: Values Champions: Central to Nation-Building

- Examine the values champion as a catalyst for change, identifying their roles and responsibilities as key drivers of ethical governance.
- Create a framework to lead from within agencies and communities, ensuring the longevity and resilience of the values restoration movement.

#### Session 5: Forging a Stronger Foundation: The Art of Fortitude and Community

- · Collaborate to build collective strength and enduring impact through a practical discussion on best practices.
- · Develop strategies for fostering a strong community of practice and ensuring the continuity of the values restoration movement.

#### Session 6: Build to Last, Built to Impact: Securing the Legacy

- · Revisit one's commitment and ensure that building efforts are in line with the established blueprint.
- · Formulate strategies for long-term sustainability to ensure a lasting legacy.

#### Interactive / Workshop / Integration Sessions

These sessions will provide opportunities for hands-on activities, group discussions, and knowledge integration. Participants will work together to apply the concepts learned, share best practices, and develop a collective roadmap for rebuilding a more valuesdriven nation.

Venue & Set-Up

The VRP Capacity Building XI will be a hybrid event, offering both in-person participation at the Tagaytay Country Hotel and a virtual experience online. This setup is designed to create a dynamic and engaging environment for all attendees. Participants are encouraged to be digitally equipped for seamless access to QR codes, links, and additional resources.

A private Facebook group will be created exclusively for all attendees to facilitate seamless access to resources, including slides and photos. This group will also serve as a hub for interactive discussion and a platform for live recordings, which will be available for unlimited viewing for 30 days after the event. Facebook Live will serve as a backup to the main Zoom platform.

Training Fee, Inclusions, Payment Details

Participation in the VRP Capacity Building XI will earn attendees a certificate for 24 leadership training hours. For full-board attendees, the first meal will be dinner on November 18, 2025. The early bird rate applies to payments made on or before October 31, 2025, with the regular rate applicable thereafter.
