Date: October 22, 2025

In reference to Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) Council Circular No. 35, s. 2025, this Office informs all concerned of the conduct of the following activities:

- 44th Councilwide Camp
- Troop Leaders' Update on Community Development Project and Outdoor Skills Training
- Twinklers and Stars Holiday

44th Councilwide Camp

The 44th Councilwide Camp shall be held on November 27-30, 2025, at Padada Central Elementary School and Padada South Elementary School Grounds, Padada District, Municipality of Padada, as part of the annual outdoor leadership program of the Council.

The details are as follows:

Participants: Junior, Senior, and Cadet Scouts (to be chaperoned by a Troop Leader)
Ratio: Two (2) leaders per six (6) to eight (8) girls

Recognition: Awards and gift items shall be given to districts and secondary schools with at least forty (40) girl attendees and above.

Event Fee: Php 1,200.00 per participant (inclusive of event t-shirt, bus/van rental for offsite activities, camping and program materials, office supplies, certificates/awards, activity cards)



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and badges, group insurance, physical arrangements, and other operational expenses)

Health Requirement: Participants must be physically healthy and can sustain strenuous outdoor activities.

Theme: "Embracing the Girl Scout Motto: Be Ready, Take Action."

Pre-Camp Activity: Districts and schools are advised to conduct pre-camp training on November 15–16, 2025, to ensure that girls are adequately prepared and registered in advance.

Camp Objectives:

- to enhance leadership and teamwork skills;
- to promote discipline and self-reliance;
- to foster unity among Girl Scouts across the province; and
- to provide practical outdoor skills and experiences.

Note: Districts and schools are encouraged to allocate additional budget for the meals and snacks of the participating girls and troop leaders.

Troop Leaders' Update on Community Development Project and Outdoor Skills Training

The Troop Leaders' Update on Community Development Project and Outdoor Skills Training, which includes the Magic Spot Project, Pilar Hidalgo Lim Troop Award, and Dr. Amelita Dayrit Go Community-Based Troop Membership Achievement Award, shall be conducted concurrently with the Councilwide Camp.

Participants: Troop Leaders who are not delegates of the encampment

Registration Fee: Php 1,200.00 per participant (inclusive of event t-shirt, four meals and snacks, certificates, training materials, and operational expenses)

Reminders: Participants are advised to bring their own bedroll or sleeping gear.

Twinklers and Stars Holiday

The Twinklers and Stars Holiday shall be held on November 29, 2025, at the Padada Central Elementary School Gym.

Participants: Twinklers and Star Scouts (to be chaperoned by a parent, troop leader, or guardian)



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Registration Fee: Php 500.00 per participant (inclusive of event t-shirt, certificates, badges, lunch, and other operational expenses)

Pre-Camp: Leaders are requested to conduct a pre-camp with their girls.

Food: Participants must bring their own packed snacks.

Health Requirement: Participants must be physically healthy and duly registered.

Further details on the above activities shall be issued through a separate communication.

All districts and schools are enjoined to support and promote these annual outdoor leadership activities, which provide opportunities for Girl Scouts to explore, learn, and grow through the joy and meaningful experiences of camping.

Service Credits shall be granted to teachers who will attend the activity, while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be provided to non-teaching personnel who will render services, in accordance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003.

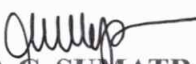

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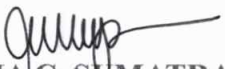
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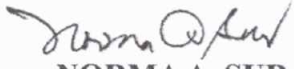
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
