CONDUCT OF ADM RE-ORIENTATION CUM DEVELOPMENT OF DIVISION AND SCHOOL IMPLEMENTATION PLAN TO REDUCE DROP OUT RATE AND MAPPING AND TRACKING OF SARDOS IN ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS

Date: November 5, 2025

In line with the Department of Education's commitment to provide inclusive and equitable quality education, the Schools Division Office of Digos City will conduct a re-orientation on Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) cum Development of Division and School Implementation Plan to Reduce Dropout Rate and Mapping and Tracking of Students-at-Risk of Dropping Out (SARDOs) among elementary and secondary schools.

The activity aims to:

- a. Re-orient school heads, teachers, and education officials on the principles and importance of ADM in addressing dropout rates, with a particular focus on SARDOs.
- b. develop and implement school-specific plans for mapping and tracking SARDOs to prevent further dropout.
- c. Share and discuss mechanism on integratig GAD-sensitive strategies into the ADM implementation plan to address gender-specific barriers, ensuring that both male and female students are supported; and
- d. establish a monitoring and evaluation system to assess the effectiveness of ADM interventions in tracking and supporting SARDOs.
