- November 29, 2025 – Cultural and heritage exposure at Binondo and Divisoria
- November 30, 2025 – Return to Davao

2025.

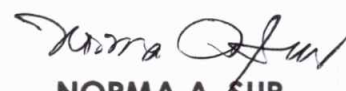
Furthermore, may we request that Service Credits will be granted to teachers and

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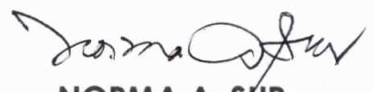
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
