- 1. The Wins Policy or DepEd Order No. 10, s.2016 titled: Policy and Guidelines for the Comprehensive Water, Sanitation and Hygiene in Schools (Wins) Program was issued February 19, 2016. The Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene in Schools. The Health and well-being of learners are foundational to their academic performance and holistic development.
