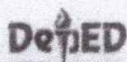

3. For the Opening Ceremony on December 1, 2025, there will be a Parade of Colors to be participated in by all participants.
 - All regions must prepare their respective flags and wear regional costume/Filipiniana/Barong.

4. There will be an election of officers for the School Health and Nutrition Personnel Association (SHNPAP) and Department of Education Nutritionist-Dietitians Association (DENDA) to be held on December 2, 2025. Newly elected national officers shall have their oath-taking during the Fellowship night on December 3, 2025
5. For the Fellowship Night on December 3, 2025:
 - Each discipline is requested to organize intermission numbers.

6. Travel expenses shall be charged against the 2024 downloaded travel funds allocated for the School Health Personnel Convergence. In view of the change in the date and venue of the activity, should there be deficiencies in the downloaded funds, expenses may be augmented using the Program Support Funds (PSF), School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) funds, or local funds subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

For participants from BARMM, accommodation will be provided; however, travel expenses shall be charged against their respective local funds.

7. There will be a National Vision Screening Program Training on December 3, 2025 to be participated in by Medical Officers and nurses. Pre-identified trained health personnel from Region IX are requested to serve as trainers during this activity. Please refer to Annex C for the list of identified personnel.
8. To ensure the safety and well-being of all attendees, strict adherence to health protocols shall be observed throughout the event.
- a. All participants are encouraged to bring and wear face masks, especially in enclosed or crowded areas.
 - b. Individuals experiencing symptoms of illness (e.g. fever, cough, sore throat) are advised not to attend the event.
 - c. Frequent hand hygiene is strongly encouraged. Hand sanitizers and alcohol stations will be available throughout the venue.
 - d. Any participant who becomes unwell during the event must report immediately to the designated health desk for assessment and appropriate
 - e. action.

ANNEX A

Guidelines for the Grant of Loyalty Awards and Recognition of Retirees

I. Purpose

These guidelines aim to provide clear and consistent procedures for the granting of **Loyalty Awards** to qualified employees who have rendered **25 or more years of continuous and satisfactory government service as of September 30, 2025**, and to **recognize employees who have retired or will retire from the period of December 2018 to December 2025**.

II. Coverage

These guidelines apply to all eligible school health and nutrition employees of the Department of Education (DepEd), including those who are permanent and contractual, by applicable civil service rules and regulations.

III. Eligibility

A. Loyalty Award

An employee shall be eligible for the Loyalty Award if they meet the following criteria:

1. Has completed **at least 25 years of continuous and satisfactory service** in the government;
2. Is **in active service** as of **November 30, 2025**;
3. Has **no pending administrative or criminal case**;

B. Retirement Recognition

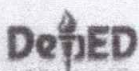
An employee shall be eligible for Retirement Recognition if:

1. They have **retired or will retire** from the service from the period of **December 2018 - December 2025**;
2. They have completed **at least 15 years of government service**;
3. They are retiring under **mandatory, optional, or disability retirement**, duly approved by the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS);
4. They have **no pending administrative case** at the time of retirement;
5. Their government service has been **honorable and satisfactory**.

The respective Regional Office, through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD) - School Health and Nutrition Section, shall facilitate the registration and confirmation of the list of their eligible health personnel.
