This program seeks to empower learners as active partners in educational transformation, consistent with the goals of DepEd's Youth Formation Division (YFD) to nurture competent, caring, and collaborative student leaders who uphold the core Filipino values of maka-Diyos, maka-tao, maka-kalikasan, at maka-bansa. Through plenary discussions, breakout workshops, and peer-led learning circles, participants will gain the knowledge and skills to lead initiatives in school improvement, learner participation, environmental stewardship, digital citizenship, and mental-health advocacy.

Beyond leadership theory, the conference emphasizes transformative and participatory leadership practice, encouraging student leaders to design school-based projects and governance innovations that promote learner well-being, inclusion, and academic excellence. Guided by educators and youth formation specialists, delegates will co-create their Student Empowerment and Action Plan (SEAP), a framework that translates national youth formation goals into concrete school-level programs.
