

We are the Ateneo Mathematics Society (AMS), a student-led organization of the Ateneo de Manila University, we are writing this letter to invite you to **Sipnayan 2026: To The Seven Seas**. As one of the flagship projects of our organization, Sipnayan is an annual mathematics competition open to students all over the Philippines to pursue excellence and showcase their mathematical abilities.

To provide further context and guidance, here are pertinent information about the said event:

#### Competition

- **Modality:** To be held onsite in the Ateneo de Manila University, Katipunan Avenue, Quezon City
- **Divisions:** The whole competition will consist of three [3] different divisions
  1. Grade School Division (Grades 4–6)
  2. Junior High School Division (Grades 7–10)
  3. Senior High School Division (Grades 11–12)
- **Stages:** Every division will have three (3) rounds:
  1. Written Elimination Round
  2. Oral Semi-Final Round
  3. Oral Final Round
- **Registration:**
  - Early Registration Fee (November 17 to November 28, 2025):
    - PHP 1,000 / team (Private Schools)
    - PHP 850 / team (Public or Science Schools)
  - Regular Registration Fee (November 29 to December 5, 2025):
    - PHP 1,250 / team (Private Schools)
    - PHP 1,100 / team (Public or Science Schools)
  - Discount, for teams that have all members attending the workshops:
    - Less PHP 200 / team (Private Schools)
    - Less PHP 250 / team (Public or Science Schools)
  - Each school may enter a maximum of three (3) teams per division, with each team composed of three (3) students.
