CAMP**

Date : December 26, 2025

In reference to the Regional Memorandum CLMD-2025-645 dated November 17, 2025, re: **Regional Schools Press Conference and Journalism Camp**, this office informs the field of the conduct of the **Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC)** and **Journalism Camp** with the theme, **“Journalism Amplifying Youth’s Voices: Informing, Inspiring, Impacting”** on January 26-28, 2026 in Mati City and January 29-31, 2026 at RNEAP XI, Davao City.

The conference aims to:

- a. demonstrate understanding of journalism through skillful execution of journalistic skills in various platforms such as print and broadcast media.
- b. recognize the role of journalism in advocating social consciousness and environmental awareness.
- c. promote fair and ethical use of media as tenets of responsible journalism.
- d. foster camaraderie and enrich learning experiences through healthy and friendly competition.
- e. provide learners opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism for their future careers.

Found in the enclosures are the General Guidelines of the different competitions, and timelines for the RSPC (S.Y 2025-2026).

The **“No School Paper, No Student Contestant”** policy should be strictly followed to ensure that all participants are actively engaged in practicing their journalistic skills both print and online. All campus journalists must secure a **parent’s consent** and obtain a **medical certificate**, completing these pre-RSPC



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requirements at least one week before the event. Coaches are responsible for arranging the safest and most convenient transportation for their journalists traveling to Mati City and Davao City.

All participants must pay a registration fee of ₱600.00, which should be collected by the Treasurer of the Digos City Association of School Paper Advisers (DCASPA) and shall be remitted to the Regional Office Cashier on January 16, 2026, to defray expenses for the certificates, medals, plaques, trophies, honoraria of judges, accommodations, assistance to host schools and meals.

Moreover, a membership fee of **One Hundred Pesos (Php100)** for the SPA and **Nnety Pesos (Php90)** for Campus Journalist shall be collected by the DRASPAI treasurer.

The official delegation to the RSPC is required to purchase sublimation t-shirts, priced at ₱290 for campus journalists and ₱390 for school paper advisers. For more information on shirt orders, please contact the officers of DCASPA.

All these including meals, transportation and other related expenses of the delegates are all chargeable against Schools Maintenance and other Operating Expenses/local/school/Special Education Fund, School Campus Journalism Funds and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Service credits shall be granted to teacher participants (DepEd Order No. 53, s 2003) while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to other non-teaching personnel (SC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, 2 2004) for the service rendered during weekends and holidays.

Billeting schools will be secured by the Barangay Protection Office and should have Child Protection Desk and proper Waste Management System. All participants are reminded to bring their own bedding.

REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE AND JOURNALISM CAMP

To: Schools Division Superintendents
 Chief Education Supervisor, CLMD

1. Pursuant to the thrusts and objectives of RA 7079 otherwise known as Campus Journalism Act, the Department of Education - Region XI through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division in partnership with the Davao Region Association of School Publication Advisers Inc. (DRASPAI) shall conduct the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) and Journalism Camp with the theme, *Journalism Amplifying Youth's Voices: Informing, Inspiring, Impacting* on January 26-28, 2026 in Mati City and January 29-31, 2026 at RNEAP-XI, Davao City.
2. The conference, aims to:
 - a) demonstrate understanding of journalism through skillful execution in various platforms (i.e. print, broadcast, online);
 - b) recognize the role of journalism in advocating social consciousness and environmental awareness;
 - c) promote fair and ethical use of media as tenets of responsible journalism;
 - d) foster camaraderie and enrich learning experiences through healthy and friendly competition; and
 - e) provide learners opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism for their future careers.
3. The events to be contested for 2026 RSPC are the following
 - a) **Individual Contests** such as News Writing, Editorial Writing, Feature Writing, Sports Writing, Copyreading and Headline Writing, Editorial Cartooning, Photojournalism, Science and Technology Writing and Column Writing in English and Filipino of both elementary and secondary levels and Mobile Journalism in English and Filipino secondary level;
 - b) **Group Contests** such as Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting and Collaborative Desktop Publishing (for elementary and secondary level); Online Publishing Contest, and TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting (for secondary level);
 - c) Search for **Outstanding School Paper Advisers (SPAs) and Campus Journalists (CJs)**;
 - d) **School Paper Category** which includes six sections: News Section, Features Section, Editorial Section, Sports Section, Science and Technology Section and Layout and Page Design; and
4. The following shall be the official participants in the 2026 RSPC:
 - a) Top three division winners of the individual writing contests;
 - b) The first place winners in Group Contests;



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- c) School Publication Advisers;
 - d) Division Campus Journalism Focal Persons; and
 - e) Regional Technical Working Group.
5. Meals, transportation and other related expenses of the division delegates shall be managed by each division.
6. Membership fees of One Hundred Pesos (Php 100.00) for the SPA and Ninety Pesos (Php 90.00) for CJ shall be collected by the DRASPAI Treasurer. These are all chargeable against School's Maintenance and other Operating Expenses/ local/school/Special Education Fund, School Campus Journalism Funds and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Recognizing and respecting Intellectual Property Rights, the Office adheres to the rule concerning plagiarism. This Department reiterates its stand to disqualify school paper found to have copied and published texts, graphics, and other materials without duly acknowledging their sources. The disqualification covers all sections of the school paper whether they are published in print or electronically. The Division Supervisors In-Charge of campus journalism shall be responsible for this aspect.
8. SDOs are enjoined to strictly follow the **"No School Paper, No Student Contestant"** in conducting the contest at the division level ensuring that all participants have their respective school paper. School paper must be published in print or electronically which shall be the basis in school paper category evaluation.
9. The top three winners in all events per level per medium shall be recognized and the points from individual and group contests shall be included in the computation of the overall scores following the guidelines. However, the Regional Office reserves the right to carefully select the official delegates to the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC).
10. Service credits shall be granted to teacher participants (DepEd Order No. 53, s 2003) while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to other non-teaching personnel (SC and DBM Joint Circular No.2, s 2004) for the services rendered during weekends and holidays.
11. Billeting Schools will be secured by the Barangay Protection Office and should have Child Protection Desk and proper Waste Management System. All participants are reminded to bring own bedding. Schools used as billeting quarters and contest venues shall adopt the blended learning modality.

CRITERIA FOR THE SEARCH FOR THE MOST OUTSTANDING SCHOOL PAPER ADVISER

1. The Regional Office shall conduct the selection for one Outstanding School Paper Adviser and one Outstanding Campus Journalist for both Secondary and Elementary levels.
2. Each division should have only one entry for every category based on the criteria provided by the Regional Office.
3. Candidates shall be ranked based on the total points garnered. The top three (3) shall be given the following equivalent points, for consideration in the computation of the overall standing of the division, to wit:
 1st place – 5 points 2nd place – 3 points 3rd place – 1 point
4. The Selection Committee shall be composed of the following: 1 Chair: Chief of CLMD, Members Regional Coordinator of Campus Journalism, one Regional Education Program Supervisor, and President of the Association of Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers as needed.
5. Each division shall have one (1) entry per category (CJ/ SPA- elementary/ secondary) for the search. Deadline for submission of pertinent documents will be on **December 19, 2025** at CLMD Office, DepEd RO XI, Torres St. Davao City and Face to face Interview of applicants for the Search for Outstanding School Paper Adviser and Campus Journalist shall be on **January 9, 2026**.

Basic Qualification: Must have been a school paper adviser for at least three (3) consecutive years, immediately prior to the search.

Guidelines for School Paper Contest

School Paper Category includes six (6) sections: News Section, Features Section, Editorial Section, Sports Section, Science and Technology Section and Layout and Page Design.

a. Process Observed by Region XI on School Paper

In the pursuit of academic integrity and journalistic excellence, the use of a plagiarism checker in school paper publication is an essential quality assurance measure. As campus journalism aims to develop critical thinking, originality, and ethical writing among students, ensuring that all written outputs are authentic and properly attributed is crucial.

b. Objectives of the Process Flow

- i. To establish process flow in the submission of school papers from the Division Offices to achieve orderly and organized selection of entries for the NSPC
- ii. To ensure school paper adheres to standards in journalism like the content, layout, and anti-plagiarism rules
- iii. To showcase and recognize the best School Papers in Davao Region

c. Process Flow

- 1) The Davao Region School Paper Contest follows a structured and systematic process to ensure quality, originality, and compliance with established editorial and anti-plagiarism standards as school papers progress from the school level to the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC).
- 2) The process begins with the School Paper Adviser, who is responsible for the initial checking of the school paper. This includes assessing the content, layout, and strict adherence to anti-plagiarism rules and regulations. School Paper Adviser may use available online plagiarism checkers like Grammarly, SmallSEOTools, Quilbot, Duplichecker, etc. Once the school paper meets these requirements, it is finalized for circulation and submitted to the School Principal for approval.
- 3) The School Principal, upon verification of the content, issues a certificate of circulation, which signifies that the school paper is ready for submission to the Division Journalism Focal Person.
- 4) At the division level, the Division Journalism Focal accepts the school paper and performs thorough evaluation, reviewing again the content and adherence to anti-plagiarism standards. The Division will conduct plagiarism check using online plagiarism checker. Once verified, the paper and plagiarism check results are endorsed to the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) for official submission to the Regional Journalism Focal.
- 5) The Regional Journalism Focal then accepts the school paper and subjects it to rigorous evaluation by assigned evaluators during the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC). The evaluators provide detailed feedback and recommendations, particularly on content quality, layout, and originality, ensuring that only the most exemplary entries per section are identified as winners.




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- 6) Following the RSPC, winning school papers undergo another round of refinement and enhancement in preparation for the NSPC. The School Paper Adviser is once again responsible for refining the paper based on evaluator feedback—improving content, redesigning layout, and ensuring full compliance with anti-plagiarism standards.
- 7) Once enhanced, the school paper is submitted directly to the Regional Journalism Focal, who will conduct a final review before endorsing the entry to the Regional Director for certification. The certified school paper is then submitted to the NSPC Coordinator for national-level competition.
- 8) This process highlights the collaborative effort among advisers, principals, division and regional officials, and evaluators to uphold high journalistic standards and integrity in campus publications. It ensures that school papers not only reflect student voice and creativity but also meet professional and ethical benchmarks required at the national level.



d. Selection of Best School Paper

Regional Evaluators will evaluate and select the **Top 5 school paper** entries for the 6 sections/categories for elementary and Secondary in both mediums. RSPC will adhere to the recent guidelines of the NSPC School Paper Contest. Below are the categories to be contested:

- i. News Section
- ii. Features Section
- iii. Editorial Section
- iv. Sports Section
- v. Science and Technology Section
- vi. Layout and Page Design
