In reference to Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) Council Circular No. 45, Series of 2026, received on January 20, 2026, this Office hereby informs all concerned of the conduct of the **Search for the Most Popular Girl Scouts 2026**, as part of the Council Anniversary Activities of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP), Davao del Sur Girl Scout Council.

**Coverage and Participation**

1. The search is open to all age levels: **Twinkler Scouts, Star Scouts, Junior Scouts, Senior Scouts, and Cadet Scouts.**
2. Districts may nominate one (1) candidate (from Twinkler, Star or Junior Scouts) to represent the district or one (1) candidate per age level. Secondary schools may nominate candidates from **Senior or Cadet Scout** levels.
3. Qualifications of Candidates:
  - Must be a registered Girl Scout
  - Payment of a qualifying fee of **Five Hundred Pesos (₱500.00)**

**Sharing of Funds**

- 20% – Seller or candidate share
- 20% – District / Secondary School share
- 10% – District share deposited to the Council for activities
- 20% – District share for coronation expenses
- 30% – Council share

Only 60% representing the Council and District shares shall be placed inside the canvassing box.

## Coronation

The **Coronation Rites** shall be held on **March 7, 2026**. Venue details shall be announced later.

DepEd personnel attending activities related to the Search shall be granted Service Credits or Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC), in accordance with DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024.

Please be informed that one of the activities during the Council Anniversary is the Coronation of the Search for the Most Popular Girl Scouts 2026. This is a Traditional fund-raising project of the Council for the Fiscal Year July 2025 – June 2026. Proceeds of the project will be deposited to the General Fund for Council Operation and Anniversary operation. Below are the mechanics of the contest:

1. The Search for the Most Popular Girl Scouts is open to all age levels: **TWINKLER SCOUTS, STAR, JUNIOR, SENIOR AND CADET SCOUTS.**
2. Districts may choose one candidate (from Twinkler, Star or Junior Scouts) that will represent their districts or have one candidate per age levels. The Secondary schools may choose from Senior or Cadet age levels.
3. Qualification of candidates:
  - Must be a registered girl scout
  - Payment of qualifying fee of Php500.00
4. Sharing of Funds:
  - ⊕ 20% Seller or candidate share
  - ⊕ 20 % district/Secondary School Share
  - ⊕ 10% district share deposited at the council for activities
  - ⊕ 20% district share for Coronation expenses
  - ⊕ 30% council share

Only 60% thereof representing the council share and district share shall be placed/dropped inside the canvassing box.

5. Schedule of counting's:
  - First counting - January 31, 2026, 2:00 p.m.  
GSP Conference Hall
  - Second and Final counting - February 17, 2026 – 2:00 p.m.  
GSP Conference Hall

6. The Coronation rites will be held on March 7, 2026 and the venue will be announced later.

Furthermore, may we request Service Credits for the teachers and compensatory overtime credits (COC) shall likewise be granted to commissioners and non-teaching staff participants.
