Also, everyone is expected to wear their complete Type "A" Scout Uniform during the forum.

Please be advised that the Opening Program will start at exactly 7:00 PM on January 30, 2026.

All other details are found in the enclosure for ready reference.

Corresponding compensatory overtime credit or Service Credit (COC/SC) shall be granted for the services rendered on Saturday and Sunday (January 31, 2026 and February 1, 2026) as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 013, s. 2024 once necessary documents are found to be in order.



Subject: **2026 COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM**

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines - Davao del Sur-Occidental Council is pleased to announce the conduct of the 2025 COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM on **January 30 to February 01, 2026** at Gov. Nonito D. Llanos Sr. National High School, Brgy. Balasiao, Kiblawan, Davao del Sur.
2. The activity aims to provide opportunities for the youth to communicate, discuss matters, and formulate solutions on issues affecting them including issues of the government; establish a feedback system on which Scouts can evaluate the effectiveness of the Scout program and relay such to governing bodies of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines; and elect two (2) Scout Representatives who will sit in the Local Council Executive Board representing the youth section and to represent the Local Council to the Regional Scout Youth Forum.
3. Participating Scouts must be currently registered as a Senior Scout with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines and must be at least 15 to 17 years old at day of the forum. Each Secondary School may send **three (3) scout-participants** and **one (1) accompanying Adult Leader**.
4. A REGISTRATION FEE of **₱300.00** shall be collected for this activity to defray costs for forum materials and other administrative expenses. All participants and accompanying adults are hereby advised to preferably bring a laptop and provide their own tent and/or sleeping gears, toiletries, food for the whole duration of the activity and other personal necessities. Also, everyone is expected to wear their complete Type "A" Scout Uniform during the forum.
5. Please be advised that the Opening Program will start at exactly 7:00 PM on January 30, 2026.
6. Corresponding service credits shall be granted to all accompanying adults as provided for by DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012.
