Subject : **INTEGRATED HELMINTHS CONTROL PROGRAM (IHCP)**

Date : February 20,2026

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) in the Philippines conducts school-based deworming activity semi-annually in partnership with the Department of Health (DOH) to deworm public school learners (DM No.80, s.2015). Deworming activity under the program of Water and Sanitation Hygiene (WASH) strive to provide a healthy learners.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. To deworm at least 85% of school children (DO. No.10, s. 2016).
 - b. To free learners from intestinal worms that may deprive them of nutrients and cause illness.
 - c. To reduce harmful intestinal parasites circulating in the environment
 - d. To reduce absenteeism brought by symptoms of worm infections.
 - e. To improve physical and mental potential.
3. In order to successfully implement the Mass Drug Administration; all elementary School clinic Coordinators are hereby directed to join the virtual meeting on February 23,2026, 1:00pm to 5:00pm link will be send through HIMSOG group chat and respective district group chat.
4. School shall ensure that school children will take the deworming drugs on full stomach and with approved/signed parents' consent, "No parents consent No deworming Administration".

<p>a. Prepare Master list of School learners</p> <p>b. Ensure availability of deworming and supportive drugs</p> <p><u>Remember the following:</u></p> <p>Recommended Drug for Deworming treatment</p> <p>Albendazole 400mg chewable flavoured tablet</p> <p><u>Precautionary Measures on Deworming Administration</u></p>	<p>-Clean drinking water should be available at the school treatment day.</p> <p>-Each learner shall receive one tablet of deworming drug.</p> <p>- The names of the children who are absent during the deworming day should be recorded by the teacher and these children should be treated when they return to school. Children who are ill on treatment day should not receive drugs, to prevent the potential misperception that the deworming medicine caused the illness. They can take the deworming drugs later when they are well again.</p> <p>In case of adverse event following intake of the deworming medicines/drugs notify your Barangay Midwives/BHW and district nurse/s</p>	<p>The class adviser shall make sure that all children listed in the Master list with Parents' Consent were given deworming drugs.</p> <p>Submission of Accomplishment Report to the Division Office will be collected by your respective district Nurse/s</p>
<p>Albendazole is not recommended if the child:</p>		
<p>-is seriously ill</p>		
<p>-has high fever</p>		
<p>-is experiencing abdominal pain;</p>
