This initiative aims to promote environmental awareness, community engagement, and collective responsibility in protecting and preserving our vital water resources, particularly the Digos River.


All interested participants are advised to bring gloves, reusable water bottles and wear comfortable clothing suitable for outdoor activities.

Participation in this activity is voluntary but highly encouraged as part of our shared commitment to environmental sustainability and community service.




