This Office informs all concerned of the request of the City Government of Digos, through the Digos City Anti-Drug Abuse Council Office (DICADA0), regarding the conduct of a School-Based Information and Education Campaign (IEC) on the Ill Effects of Illegal Drug Use, as discussed during the Joint CPOC and CADAC1st Quarterly Meeting last February 6, 2026.
 2. The activity aims to strengthen anti-drug advocacy efforts and promote awareness among learners on the harmful effects of illegal drug use.
 3. The Schools Division Office of Digos City interposes **no objection** to the conduct of the said IEC, provided that it strictly complies with DepEd Order No. 9, s.2005, **“Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith,”** specifically the **No Disruption of Classes** policy. The activity must not interrupt regular classes or scheduled school-related undertakings.
 4. In line with this, authorized personnel from DICADA0 may directly visit schools to coordinate with the School Heads regarding the proposed schedule. School Heads are directed to ensure that the activity is arranged in alignment with the school calendar, existing school policies, and the protection of instructional time.
 5. All School Heads are advised to extend full support and coordination to DICADA0 in the implementation of this initiative, while ensuring the smooth and orderly conduct of all school operations.




