
Subject : **PARTICIPATION IN RABIES AWARENESS MONTH INFORMATION,

1. In reference to the request of the Provincial Veterinary Office of Davao del Sur regarding the conduct of **Information, Education and Communication (IEC) campaigns in celebration of Rabies Awareness Month this March 2026**, all concerned schools are hereby informed of the activity.

 - c) Ensure proper supervision of learners at all times.
