The 2026 Innovation Grants is open for government agencies, including departments, bureaus, State Universities and Colleges (SUCs), schools, Government-Owned and Controlled Corporations, Local Government Units, and other instrumentalities.

To further guide interested parties in their respective applications, the DEPDev Innovation Staff will conduct an orientation-workshop to discuss the salient features of the implementing guidelines, provide tips on proposal writing, and demonstrate the features of the Electronic Innovation Grants Information System (EIGIS).
