1. In line with these, all Regional Offices are hereby enjoined to proceed with the conduct of training for Alternative Learning System (ALS) teachers to ensure the effective cascading and implementation of the Revised ALS Curriculum.

The Training Resource Package (TRP) may be accessed through the official link provided or by scanning the QR code on the next page. The TRP includes the official slide decks, session guides, training matrix, pre-test and post-test instruments, and other training materials necessary for the conduct of the training. The TRP shall serve as the primary and official reference materials to ensure standardization, consistency, and alignment with the objectives of the Enhanced ALS. No modification, alteration, or substitution of the contents of the TRP shall be made to ensure uniformity and fidelity in the implementation of the Revised ALS Curriculum nationwide.

The funding requirements for the conduct of the training shall be charged against the downloaded Program Support Fund (PSF), as provided in DM-CT-2025-207. Accordingly, all Regional Offices are hereby directed to submit their proposed training schedules on or before **February 6, 2026**, through the official email address of the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE).
