Aguinaldo National High School, while travel and incidental expenses will be charged against local/MOOE funds or other sources all subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. PROJECT MENTOR DEVELOPMENT AND UPSKILLING TRAINING**

1. The Department of Education Regional Office XI, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the Inter-Division Science Investigatory Project Mentor Development and Upskilling Training on May 13-15, 2026, at Daniel R. Aguinaldo National High School, Matina Crossing, Davao City with 15.2 Continuing Professional Development (CPD) units to be awarded to participants.
2. The activity aims to: a) enhance Junior and Senior High School science teachers' knowledge and skills in mentoring learners in developing high-quality Science Investigatory Projects (SIPs) aligned with research standards and ethical practices; b) strengthen teachers' competencies in guiding learners through the research process—from problem identification to scientific communication; and c) equip participants with updated strategies and best practices in coaching and evaluating SIPs to improve learner performance in science research competitions.
3. Participants in this activity are potential Science Investigatory Project (SIP) coaches from Schools Division Offices (SDOs) who handle science research subjects. They are encouraged to bring laptops, extension wires, and pocket Wi-Fi. The allocation of participants and program management team members is enclosed. Teaching personnel shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, while non-teaching personnel, including management staff, shall be granted Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) pursuant to CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2024, particularly Section 5.
4. Lunch and two snacks for the participants shall be charged against the downloaded funds to Daniel R. Aguinaldo National High School while traveling and incidental expenses shall be charged against local/MOOE funds or other sources of funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants who wish to be billeted at Daniel R. Aguinaldo National High School may avail of accommodation free of charge.

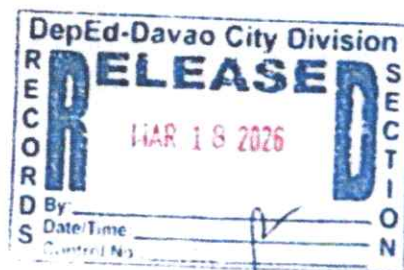
