In support of the Department of Education's commitment to improving foundational literacy and numeracy among learners, and in line with the continuous strengthening of learner-centered interventions, this Office intensifies the implementation of the Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL) approach across schools in the division. TaRL is an evidence-based instructional strategy that focuses on assessing learners according to their current learning levels and providing targeted instruction appropriate to their needs, thereby improving learning outcomes and addressing learning gaps.

Relative thereto, this Office hereby directs all concerned School Heads and teachers to attend the Online Training of Teachers and School Heads on Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL) – Batch 4 on May 13, 15, & 22, 2026, via Google Meet through the following link: <https://meet.google.com/qwk-aanj-qnb>.

The activity aims to:

1. strengthen the capacity of School Heads and teachers in implementing the Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL) approach in improving foundational learning among learners;
2. deepen participants' understanding of learner assessment, grouping strategies, and differentiated instruction aligned with the principles of TaRL;
3. equip participants with appropriate pedagogical strategies, learning interventions, and monitoring tools necessary for effective TaRL implementation;
4. promote collaborative learning and sharing of best practices among teachers and school leaders in addressing learners' diverse educational needs; and
5. ensure the effective and uniform implementation of the TaRL Program across schools in support of improving learners' literacy and numeracy outcomes.

Participants of this online training are likewise expected to attend the Pre-Training Orientation on May 11, 2026 at 9:00 AM, via Google Meet through the following link: <https://meet.google.com/urv-vxhk-tch>.

In accordance with existing guidelines, teaching personnel shall be granted vacation service credits for services rendered during summer break, weekends, and holidays pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, while non-teaching personnel shall be entitled to Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) for services rendered during weekends and holidays in accordance with CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 and CSC Memorandum Circular No. 41, s. 1998.
