ARAIZ, LTC (INF) PA, Director, Office of the Cadet Recruitment and Admission, Philippine Military Academy (PMA), regarding the conduct of the Philippine Military Academy Entrance Examination (PMAEE) 2026.

The PMAEE 2026 is scheduled from July to September 2026. For Davao Region, the examination will be conducted on July 11 and 12, 2026. The testing center for Digos City is the University of Mindanao Digos College, Roxas Extension, Digos City.

In view of DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026, titled "Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education," schools are reminded to ensure compliance with existing DepEd policies and to safeguard uninterrupted learning and engaged time-on-task.

Participation shall remain voluntary, and no government funds shall be utilized for the conduct of or participation in the said activity.


