Subject : **CONDUCT OF INDOOR MISTING IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

Date : June 4, 2026

1. June is designated as Dengue Awareness Month, where the Department of Education (DepEd) actively participates in this national initiative to promote Dengue Prevention and Control in Schools.
2. In line with this, DepEd Digos City Schools Division Office reiterates DepEd Memorandum No. 152, s. 2011, "Preventing Dengue in Schools," to emphasize dengue prevention measures in schools during the rainy season, particularly focusing on the 5S strategy: Search and Destroy, Self-Protect, Seek Consultation, Support Fogging, and Sustain Hydration.
3. With the upcoming opening of classes for School year 2025-2026, the Health and Nutrition Unit will be conducting Indoor Misting Operation in public schools to ensure every school maintains a clean and safe environment.
4. Attached is the schedule of misting operation in schools located within the Barangays of Digos City.
5. This Office directs the district nurse/s, School Heads, Project Development Officer or any non-teaching personnel representative from school that are directed to accompany the City Health personnel during the misting activity.
6. Teaching and non-teaching personnel rendered services during the misting activity are entitled to earn service credits when the event/activity falls on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays in accordance with DO 53,s.2003 "granting of vacation service credits to teachers", and non-teaching personnel is entitled to Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) in accordance with CSC & DBM Joint Circular No.2,s.2024, which prescribes guidelines on the availment of Compensatory time-Off, pursuant to the adoption austerity measures in the government.


