Subject: **PARTICIPATION IN THE 2ND COUNCIL GATHERING OF GIRL LEADERS**

Date: June 30, 2026

In reference to Council Circular No. 55, s. 2026 of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, Davao del Sur Girl Scout Council, this Office informs all concerned of the conduct of the **2nd Council Gathering of Girl Leaders (CGGL)** with the theme **“The Living Light: Igniting Her Path to Leadership”** on **July 4-5, 2026**, at **Balutakay Integrated School, Bansalan East District**.

The activity aims to:

- foster friendship, camaraderie, and sisterhood among Girl Scouts;
- promote teamwork, collaboration, creativity, and problem-solving while strengthening Girl Scout values;
- provide meaningful lessons from Girl Scouting that encourage reflection, personal growth, and service;
- develop leadership skills through the patrol system by practicing decision-making, initiative, and responsibility; and
- plan and implement girl-led activities that address community needs and create positive impact.

Expected participants are Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts, Senior/Cadet Patrol Leaders, GSP Club Officers, Chief Girl Scout Medalists, and at least one patrol or eight Girl Scouts per secondary school, with an adult chaperone.

School Heads, GSP Coordinators, Troop Leaders, and adult chaperones shall ensure the safety, welfare, and proper supervision of all participating learners. Written parental consent and other required documents shall be secured prior to the activity.

A registration fee of One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00) per participant shall be collected by the GSP Council to cover program materials, event T-shirt, badges, certificates, meals, snacks, off-site activities, and other operational expenses. Participation in the activity shall be voluntary, and no learner or school personnel shall be compelled to participate or pay the registration fee.

Participating schools are requested to submit the names of participants to the GSP Council on or before **July 1, 2026**, to facilitate the preparation of event materials and T-shirts.


