The development phase shall be conducted through online and asynchronous collaborative work. The development team shall prepare the complete lesson plans for Terms 1,2 and, 3 and ensure the following:

- Alignment with prescribed curriculum standards and competencies;
- Appropriate integration of learning competencies across grade levels;
- Clear differentiated of activities, assessment tasks, and expected outputs;
- Suitability of learning activities for multigrade classroom settings;
- Contextualization based on the learners' needs and local setting; and
- adherence to the prescribed ILAW Framework and technical specifications.

In our continuing effort to safeguard instructional time and ensure uninterrupted teaching and learning, development team is enjoined to develop and prepare their lesson plans for five Saturday work sessions starting July 11,18, 25, August 1 and 8, 2026 at Soong Elementary School. In addition, as per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2005 and CSC and DBM Joint Circular no.2 s. 2004, teaching and non-teaching personnel shall be given service credits and Compensatory Time-off (CTO) respectively for services rendered during holidays or weekends.

Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against Local Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

DEVELOPMENT OF MULTIGRADE LESSON PLANS IN ILAW FRAMEWORK  
FOR TERMS 1 TO 3

To: Assistant Regional Director  
Schools Division Superintendents

1. In support of the effective implementation of the Multigrade Program and the provision of appropriate instructional resources for multigrade classes, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, shall undertake the Development of Multigrade Lesson Plans in ILAW Framework for Terms 1 to 3 through a hybrid modality.
2. The development phase shall be conducted through online and asynchronous collaborative work. The assigned Schools Division Offices and learning areas are in the enclosure. Each concerned Schools Division Office shall organize its development team composed of the Division Multigrade Focal Person, Education Program Supervisor concerned, school heads, master teachers, and competent multigrade teachers with experience in the assigned learning area and grade-level combination.
3. The development teams shall prepare the complete lesson plans for Terms 1, 2, and 3 and ensure the following:
  - a. alignment with the prescribed curriculum standards and competencies;
  - b. appropriate integration of learning competencies across grade levels;
  - c. clear differentiation of activities, assessment tasks, and expected outputs;
  - d. suitability of learning activities for multigrade classroom settings;
  - e. contextualization based on the learners' needs and local setting; and
  - f. adherence to the prescribed ILAW framework and technical specifications.
4. The completed lesson plans shall be submitted on or before July 31, 2026 through <https://tinyurl.com/lessonplanin3terms>. A face-to-face Quality Assurance Activity shall be conducted sometime in August 2026 to review, validate, refine, and finalize the developed lesson plans. The specific date, venue, participants, and other activity arrangements shall be announced through a separate memorandum.
5. Travel, accommodation and other incidental expenses during the face-to-face Quality Assurance Activity shall be charged against available Multigrade funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are directed.
