Date : July 2, 2026

Pursuant to **Section 17 of DepEd Order 13, series of 2022 (Election and Terms of Office of Federated PTA Officers)**, the **City Federated PTA Officers must be organized within 60 days from the first day of classes**. It is expected that the School PTA Organization will have been organized not later than July 30, 2026, before the conduct of the Federated PTA Election.

No Federated PTA Officer or Member of the Board of Directors shall be elected for more than two (2) consecutive terms.

In compliance with the above guidelines, an election of City PTA Federated Officers shall be conducted on **July 31, 2026, 1:30 PM at the Digos City National High School AVR**.

All School PTA Presidents (SPTA) in public elementary and secondary schools shall compose the City Federated PTA (FPTA) and are required to attend. No proxy shall be allowed.
