All expenses incurred relative to the attendance of the training shall be charged against local funds and other sources of funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

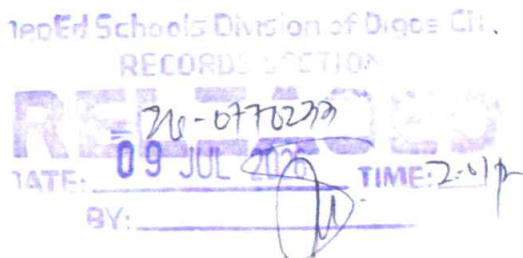
